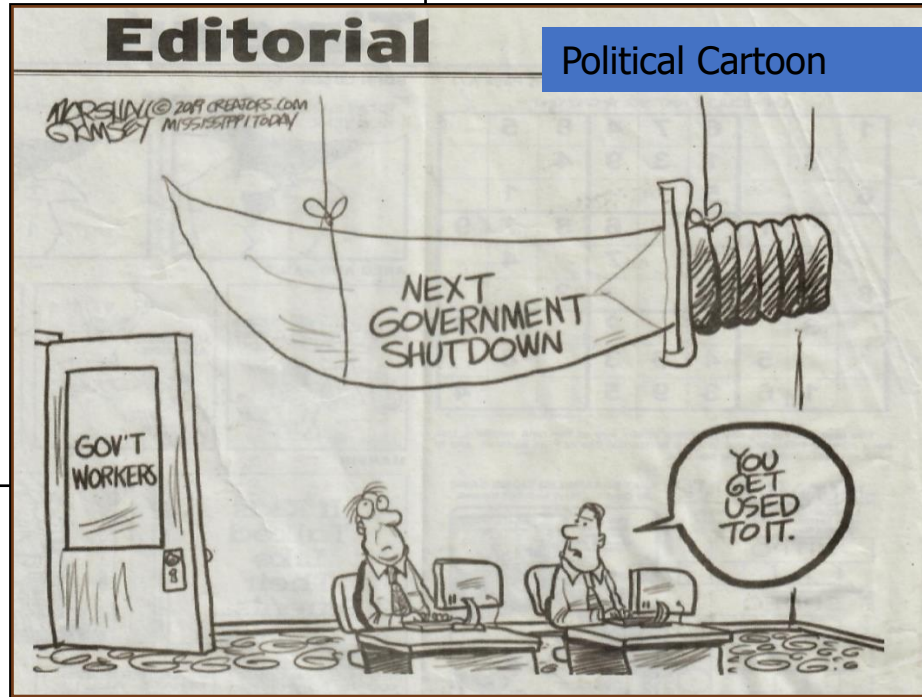

Government – political system that administers and regulates a country, city, or state
Shutdown – closure of an organization, usually temporarily
Workers – people employed to complete specific tasks

- Closure of government offices
- Loss of jobs
- Process for making gvt. budgets



1. One worker has experience working in this office
2. Same worker has been unemployed and returned to work several times before
3. Second worker is new to the job
4. Second worker is fearful of losing job
5. Closing government offices often occurs until budget is approved

Theme:
Experience reduces worry

- Details:
1. Uncertain budget for government
 2. Possible shutdown
 3. Threat of job loss generates fear - knife
 4. Having gone through loss makes it less threatening – you get used to it
